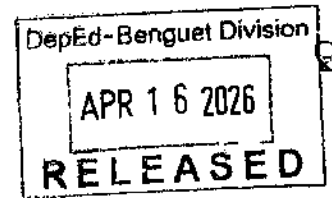

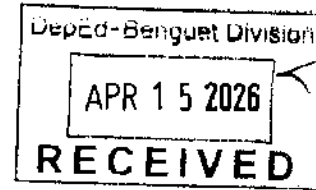

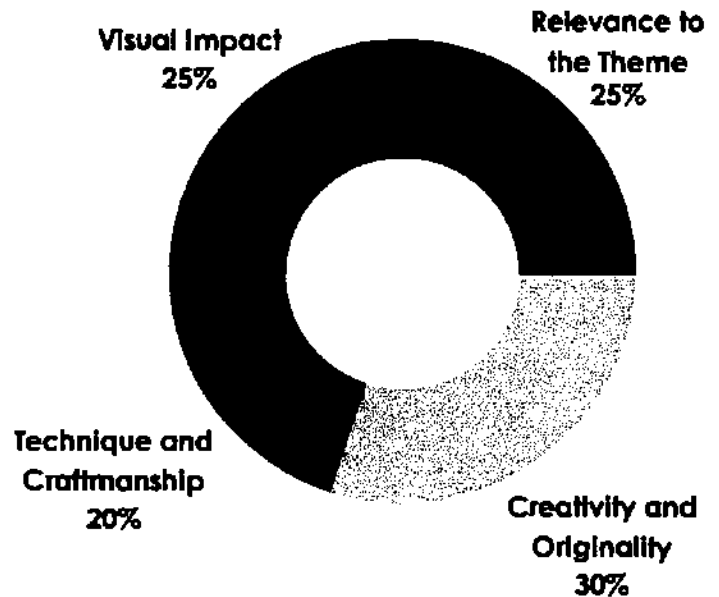
Eligibility:

- Open to SHS and college students in CAR,
- **1 participant per school**
- Individual competition.

Requirements:

- **Materials:** Must bring your own materials.
- **Allowed Materials:** White cartolina (official poster base) and oil pastel only.
- **Prohibited Materials:** Paint, markers, colored pens, and other mixed media are not allowed.
- **Size:** 22.5" x 28.5"
- **Orientation:** Landscape
- **Content:** Must visually communicate the 2026 Labor Day theme.
- **Presentation:** Must be neat and presentable.
- **Identification:** Participant details must be written at the back of the poster. One participant per school or university

Criteria for Judging:



Rules:

- **Venue:** Competition will be conducted onsite.
- **Time Limit:** Maximum of 2 hours to complete the artwork.
- **Originality:** Must be the participant's own original work.
- **Guidelines:** Participants must arrive 30 minutes early, undergo material inspection, and observe proper decorum and cleanliness throughout the competition.
- **Prohibited:** Tracing, copying from printed or digital references, use of pre-made or pre-drawn outlines, and use of gadgets are strictly not allowed.

Prizes:

1st Prize:

₱6,000.00 and a certificate of participation

2nd Prize:

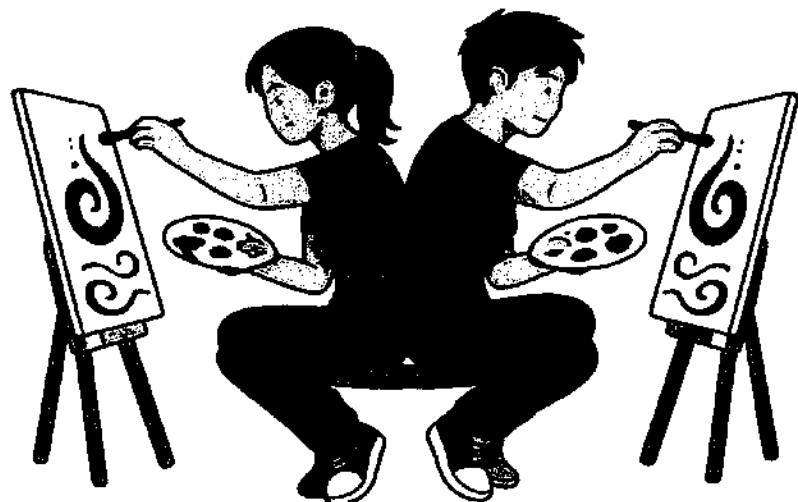
₱4,000.00 and a certificate of participation

Poster Making Competition Mechanics

I. Theme:

- All entries must clearly reflect and interpret the given theme"
- "Disenteng Trabaho para sa Lahat: lisang Hangarin, Bagong Pilipinas, Sama-samang Mararating"

II. Eligibility

- The contest is open to all Senior High School and College Students currently enrolled within the Cordillera Administrative Region
- Each School may send a maximum of 1 participant.
- This is an individual competition
- The official list of participants must be submitted through email on or before April 24, 2026.

III. Materials and Medium

- Participants must bring their own materials
- Only the following materials are allowed:
 1. White Cartolina (official poster base)
 2. Oil pastel
- The use of other materials such as paint, markers, colored pens, mixed media is strictly prohibited.

IV. Poster Specifications

- Size: 22.5" x 28.5"
- Orientation: Landscape
- The poster must observe the following:
 1. Visually communicate the theme of the 2026 Labor Day
 2. Be neat and presentable
- Participant details must be written at the back of the poster

V. Time Limit:

- The competition will be conducted onsite.
- Participant will be given a maximum of 2 hours to complete their work

VI. Originality Rule

- All entries must be original works of the participants
- The following are strictly prohibited:
 1. Tracing
 2. Copying from printed or digital references
 3. Use of pre-made or pre-drawn outlines
- Any violation will result in automatic disqualification

VII. Allowed Assistance:

- The use of gadgets is strictly prohibited during the competition
- Participants are not allowed to receive any form of assistance from coaches, companions, or other individuals

VIII. Criteria for Judging

- Entries will be based on the following criteria:

Criterion	Percentage
Creativity and Originality (Uniqueness of concept and artistic expression)	30%
Relevance to Theme (Clarity and accuracy in interpreting the theme)	25%
Visual Impact (Overall appeal and ability to capture attention)	25%
Technique and Craftmanship (Skill, neatness, and effective use of materials)	20%

IX. Judge's Decision

- The decision of the board of judges shall be final and irrevocable

X. Additional Guidelines:

- Participants must arrive at the venue at least 30 minutes before the start of the contest
- All materials will be checked prior to the competition
- Contestants must observe proper decorum and cleanliness during the event
