

- 1. The Office of the Undersecretary for Operations through Memorandum OM-OUOPS-2024-01-001191, reiterates DepEd Order No. 053, s. 2022 titled Mandatory Unannounced Earthquake and Fire Drills in Schools issued on December 9, 2022. Section 4 of the Order states that "all public schools are hereby required to conduct unannounced earthquake and fire drills every first and third week of every month." The directive is pursuant to RA 10121 or The Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010 that aims to develop disaster management capacities at the individual, organizational, and institutional level; as well as the commitment of the Department of ensuring the safety and well-being of learners and its personnel.
- 2. Furthermore, compliance with the Department's Clean School Policy, which is stipulated in Section B.2. of DepEd Order No. 021, s. 2023 is emphasized, to wit;

"Schools shall ensure that school grounds, classrooms and all its walls, and other school facilities are clean and free from unnecessary artwork, decorations, tarpaulin, and posters at all times...Classroom walls shall remain bare and devoid of posters, decorations or other posted materials. Classrooms should not be used to stockpile materials and should be clear of other unused items or items for disposal."


