



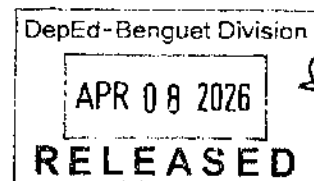

SUBMISSION OF PROPOSALS FOR THE SUMMER REMEDIATION PROGRAM

1. In line with the upcoming implementation of the 2026 Summer Remediation Program, all elementary and secondary school heads are hereby directed to submit proposals for the conduct of the program. The SRP will start May 6 and end June 2, 2026 (20-day tutorial program)
2. The Deped Summer Remediation Program aims to reinforce key competencies, strengthen learners' foundational skills, and better prepare learners for the next school year. It enables learners needing further support in Reading and Mathematics to achieve grade level proficiency. It also strengthens learners' foundational skills in English and Mathematics through targeted instruction, focused practice, and appropriate learning support to enable them to meet the demands of Senior High School. Further, it ensures that learners acquire the necessary competencies to progress to the next grade level.
3. The Summer Remediation Program includes the following:
 - a. **ARAL Summer Programs**
 - a.1 ARAL Summer- Reading for Low and High Emerging Levels based on CRLA for Key Stage 1 and Frustration 3 levels down based on Phil-IRI for Key Stages 2 and 3
 - a.2 ARAL Summer-Mathematics for not Proficient and low Proficient for incoming grades 2, 3, and 4 learners based on RMA
 - b. **Summer Academic Remedial Program** (Senior High School Program for incoming Grade 12)
 - c. **Summer Academic Remedial Program** (All Learning Areas in all grade levels)
4. The Summer Academic Remedial Program caters to learners with 1 to 2 failures in the different learning areas in all grade levels.

5. The school shall submit a letter of request to offer the Summer Remediation Program to the Schools Division Office not later than **April 30, 2026**. The school shall include the following.
1. Indicative number and list of learners to attend the program
 2. Indicative number of Teachers/Tutors available to conduct the remedial classes
 3. List of students per grade level
 4. List of least Mastered Competencies per learner
 5. List of learning area/s to be offered per grade level
 6. List of Teachers/Tutors and subjects they will teach
 7. Class Program
 8. Learners' Endorsement for Remedial Classes
 9. Parents' permit/waiver
6. The duration of the remedial classes is as follows:

Summer Remediation Program	Number of hours per learning area per day (with 30-minute break)
ARAL Summer Program: Reading/Mathematics	2 hours
Summer Academic Remedial Program: All learning areas	2 hours
Summer Academic Remedial Program: Senior High School	2 hours
