


Preparation of Contextualized Reading Materials for CAR-IRI

- 1. The CAR Informal Reading Inventory is prepared for the teachers to gather information on the student's present reading level. It includes oral assessment tool for the teacher to determine the reading level of the students and the silent reading assessment tool to determine the reading weaknesses/difficulties of the students to be addressed. These do not provide specific reading diagnosis but rather provide the teacher with a greater understanding of the student's abilities, which in turn may lead to a more accurate reading intervention addressing specific needs.
- 2. The reading program using the CAR-IRI, Ritual was implemented until grade 8 in all the secondary schools in Benguet. CAR Rituals B1 and B2 was used by the reading teachers to assess students reading weaknesses and strengths then providing appropriate intervention to remediate, enhance or enrich learners reading skills.
- 3. Based on the monitoring conducted to grade eight (8) reading teachers, there is a need to come up with additional reading materials to be used in the program since Rituals B1 and B2, as intervention materials for learners in the frustration as well as in the instructional levels are not enough. Reading Teachers are clamoring for other reading materials they can use to implement fully the program. Furthermore, there are no reading materials prepared for Grade 9. It is for these reasons that the Schools Division of Benguet through the Curriculum Implementation Division is conducting a training workshop to identified Grade 8 and Grade 9 English teachers to develop contextualize reading materials on May 23, 24, and 25, 2022 at Ecolodge, Baguio City.


