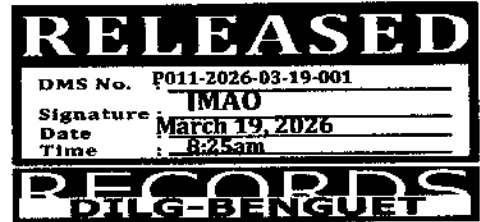
4. Expenses relative to the participation of personnel shall be charged against local funds, school MOOE, or other available sources, subject to existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

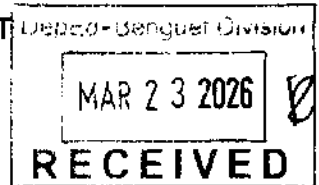
