# TRAINING OF DEPED PERSONNEL IN THE PROVISION OF PSYCHOLOGICAL FIRST AID DURING DISASTERS/EMERGENCIES

funder Project K-DRRMa focused on Mental Health, Safety and Preparedness)

To: Chiefs, CID and SGOD

Field non-teaching personnel

- 1. Under the National Disaster Response Plan (NDRP), one of the identified response actions of DepEd as the lead of the Education Cluster and as a member of the Health Cluster, is the provision of psychological first aid (PFA) to affected learners and DepEd personnel. Given the number of learners and personnel against trained personnel from 2017 to 2022, there is still a wide disparity that needs to be addressed.
- 2. As part of the gap intervention and to strengthen disaster preparedness in the SDO Benguet, a training of DepEd personnel in the provision of psychological first aid during disasters/emergencies (under Project K-DRRMa: focused on Mental Health, Safety, and Preparedness) will be conducted on July 2 4, 2024 within Baguio City (specific venue still to be determined).
- 3. After this training the participants are expected to:
  - a) Explain the concepts of Psychological First Aid;
  - b) Acquire necessary skills in PFA to be applied in the school settings; and
  - c) Facilitate the conduct of actual PFA sessions
- 4. Expected participants are administrative officers, project development officers, and other non-teaching personnel. Attached is the list of confirmed participants and the Training Matrix for reference.
- 5. For live-in participants and facilitators, full meals and accommodation will be provided while live-out participants are entitled to lunch, dinner, and snacks, chargeable against FY 2024 DPRP Funds.











- 6. The first meal for live-in participants and facilitators will be **dinner** on **July 1** while live-out participants' first meal will be **morning snacks** on **July 2**. The last meal for all participants and facilitators will be PM snack on July 4, 2024.
- 7. Transportation to and from the venue, and other incidental expenses of participants and facilitators may be charged to local funds subject to the usual existing budget, accounting, and auditing rules and regulations.
- 8. Participants are encouraged to bring comfortable clothes that are suitable for physical activities.

9. Immediate dissemination and compliance of all concerned is desired.
