





THREE ACTS OF GOODNESS SCHOOL GRANTS FOR ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOLS OF THE FO GUANG SHAN FOUNDATION, INC.

Background:

The Fo Guang Shan Foundation (FGS) Inc. will award grants to selected public and private elementary and secondary schools that successfully implement projects aligned with the principles of the Three Acts of Goodness for Cycle 10, School Year 2025-2026. The Schools Division of Benguet has consistently submitted approved proposals in previous years. Notably, in 2019, 10 personnel from SDO Benguet, out of 20 delegates nationwide, were given the opportunity to travel to Taiwan. This journey, starting from Taipei to Kaohsiung, allowed them to engage in learning immersions at TAG schools, attend seminars on well-being and leadership, and experience the rich cultural heritage of Taiwan.

The Project aims to:

1. encourage participating schools to hone their learners into holistic and noble Filipino youth through the implementation of school-based value-driven programs and projects; and
2. mold their character and improve their well-being by doing good deeds, speaking good words, and thinking good thoughts.



The specific project should align with the school's priorities and needs.

The target beneficiaries are learners or teaching and non-teaching personnel, and stakeholders of the school. Project implementers may be teaching or non-teaching personnel.

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

This Agreement was made and entered into this **MAR 14 2025** at *La Trinidad*, Benguet Philippines, by and between:

The DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION DIVISION OF BENGUET, a government entity mandated by the law, with principal address at Wangal, La Trinidad, Benguet Philippines herein represented by its REGIONAL DIRECTOR AND CONCURRENT SCHOOLS DIVISION SUPERINTENDENT, ESTELA P. LEON-CARIBO EdD CESO III, herein referred to as "DepEd".

The FO GUANG SHAN FOUNDATION, INC. a non-profit corporation organized and existing under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with office address at 656 Pablo Ocampo Street, Malate, Manila, represented in this transaction by its HEAD ABBESS, CHEN, SHU PING and hereinafter referred to as the "FOUNDATION".

WITNESSETH THAT:

WHEREAS, DepEd believes that one way of fulfilling its mandate and functions in providing a better delivery of basic education is to collaborate with other government and non-government organizations and other stakeholders for auxiliary resources;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 8525 (RA 8525), otherwise known as the "Adopt-a-School Act of 1998" was enacted to encourage private entities to assist in the delivery of better-quality education to public schools in the country, particularly in the poverty-stricken provinces;

WHEREAS, Revenue Regulations No. 10 s. 2003, implementing the Tax Incentives Provision of RA 8525, otherwise known as the Adopt-a-School Act of 1998, has been issued by the Department of Finance through the Bureau of Internal Revenue;

WHEREAS, both parties recognize and undertake compliance with Republic Act No. 10173, or the "Data Privacy Act of 2012," its Implementing Rules and Regulations, and other related issuances of the National Privacy Commission (NPC) and "Freedom of Information Order under E.O. No. 2, S. 2016" for the implementation of this Agreement;

WHEREAS, DepEd, shall comply with the applicable rules on the valuation of contributions or donations of private partners to DepEd and the proper recording of the donated items categorized as Property, Plant, and Equipment as contained in Item VII of the enclosure to DepEd Order No. 24, s. 2016 entitled "Guidelines on Accepting Donations and on Processing Applications for the Availment of Tax Incentives by Private Donor-Partners Supporting the K to 12 Program", which provides the Valuation of Assistance/Contribution or Donation and the formula of computation for the value to be reflected in the Deed of Donation and the records of donated goods and services and DepEd Order No. 82, s. 2011 entitled "Guidelines on the Proper Recording of all Donated Properties;"

WHEREAS, the Parties shall comply with the provisions of DECS Order No. 28, s. 2001 or "Prohibiting the Commercialization of the DECS Organization through Endorsements and Accreditation of Goods and Services" in the implementation of the program, and DepEd Order No. 39 s. 2009 or "Strict Adherence to DepEd Order No. 28, s. 2001";

WHEREAS, the Foundation is engaged in education and cultural programs. The Foundation initiated the "Three Acts of Goodness Grants Program" which awards a cash grant for projects of elementary and secondary schools in the Philippines that propagate the Three Acts of Goodness (TAG) *Do Good Deeds, Speak Good Words, Think Good Thoughts*, in their school.



NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises and the terms and conditions herein set forth, the parties agree as follows:

Article I. THE FO GUANG SHAN FOUNDATION, INC. SPONSORSHIP AND ADVOCACIES IN EDUCATION

The Foundation announced a call for project proposals seeking grant applications to elementary and high schools nationwide.

The Foundation, as the donor, screens and selects projects that it deems worthy of the cash grant amounting to P10,000.00 ten thousand pesos, based on how well the project integrates the Three Acts of Goodness.

The Foundation, through its TAG program, also offers, screens, and accepts applications for its tertiary scholarship programs in the management of its college known as the Guang Ming College.

Article II. PROGRAM SCOPE AND BENEFICIARY

The program encourages participating schools to hone their learners into holistic and noble Filipino youth through the implementation of school-based value-driven programs and projects to mold their character and improve their well-being by doing good deeds, speaking good words, and thinking good thoughts. This MOA will support as a legal document any donations that will be granted by the Foundation to DepEd.

The project beneficiaries should be schools of the Department of Education. A list of target beneficiary schools is attached in this MOA as annex C.

Article III. PROGRAM COST

The project known as the **THREE ACTS OF GOODNESS GRANTS FOR ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOLS** provides at least P10,000.00 for qualified and accepted proposals of schools to implement school-based projects in line with the Three Acts of Goodness. These grants will be provided to selected public schools nationwide.

The total cost of the Program is **TWENTY THOUSAND PESOS (Php 20,000.00)**. A detailed breakdown of the project cost is provided in Annex "B" which is made an integral part hereof.

Article IV. RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Section 1. DepEd shall:



- 1.1. Provide technical assistance to Fo Guang Shan Foundation, Inc. to ensure program effectiveness and efficiency;
- 1.2. Coordinate with the local government units, relevant agencies, and public schools recognized by DepEd to encourage participation within the catchment area;
- 1.3. Coordinate with the Fo Guang Shan Foundation, Inc. in the implementation of the Program, including the acceptance of the grant by recipient institutions and execution of corresponding Deeds of Acceptance through the School Heads/Principals;
- 1.4. Assist in the assessment and/or evaluation of the Program; and
- 1.5. Review and endorse the application to Fo Guang Shan Foundation Inc. for tax incentive entitlement to the Revenue District Office of the Bureau of Internal Revenue, if applicable.
- 1.6. The DepEd will assist in the implementation of the project by the proposal contained in Attachment A, from December 2024 to March 31, 2025.
- 1.7. Modification in the Approved Project Proposal is allowed provided that it will not deviate from the original proposal. Modification of any part of the project proposal must be reflected on the Terminal Report at the end of the implementation of the project.
- 1.8. The DepEd shall comply and abide by all the terms and lists of compliance provided by the Foundation's Screening Committee. Please refer to Acceptance Notice with the List of Compliance.
- 1.9. The project implementation shall be contained in a **WORK PLAN** that shall become part of this Agreement as Attachment B. Delay or deviation in the implementation of the project based on the work plan shall not be allowed without the written consent of the foundation.

Section 2. Fo Guang Shan Foundation, Inc. shall:

- 2.1. Provide funding by the scope of a project in the Program;
- 2.2. Provide materials and volunteer resources required for the Program;
- 2.3. Execute a Deed of Donation in favor of DepEd for the completed project and submit through PFI all pertinent documents in support of the amount specified/ claimed for tax incentive application;
- 2.4. Determine areas and recipient schools in close coordination with DepEd;
- 2.5. Coordinate with key local government executives and/or relevant stakeholders;
- 2.6. Support DepEd in the implementation of the Program; and
- 2.7. Render periodic assessment reports of the Program to the appropriate local government unit and/or relevant government agency.

Article V FUNDING, FINANCIAL RECORDS & REPORTS

Section 1. Provision of funds - The DepEd shall use the grant only for project-related expenses and following the approved budget plan. The School beneficiary shall submit a Certificate of Acknowledgement of the grant on or before November 28, 2024. The certificate shall be signed by the principal and shall have the official letterhead and/or logo of the school.

Section 2. *Schedule of reports* – The school shall submit a liquidation report, complete with official receipts, together with the terminal report on or before March 31, 2025.

The report shall include the following:

1. Actual status of the project
2. photos with descriptions
3. tasks completed and person-in-charge
4. usage of funds (Financial Breakdown)

Section 3. *Financial records*. – The foundation shall account for funds provided under this Agreement and shall be kept and maintained financially by the terms:

Article VI. TERM AND TERMINATION

Unless sooner terminated by one of the parties for whatever reason, this Agreement shall be carried out for a period of Two (2) years from its signing, subject to renewal for such period and under such terms and conditions agreed upon by the Parties.

Either of the Parties may terminate the MOA upon giving a 30-day notice before the intended date of termination.

Article VII. CAPACITY AND AUTHORIZATION

The Parties herein warrant that they have the capacity, power, and requisite authority to enter into this Agreement.

Article VIII. LIABILITY, INDEMNITY, AND SEPARABILITY CLAUSE

In case of breach of this Agreement, or violation of any law, the Party responsible therefor shall be solely liable and shall indemnify the Parties affected by the breach.

Any provision of this Agreement that is held invalid or unenforceable shall be ineffective to the extent of such invalidity or unenforceability without invalidating or rendering unenforceable the remaining provisions hereof, and any such invalidity or unenforceability in any jurisdiction shall not invalidate or render unenforceable such provisions in any other jurisdiction.

Article IX. BREACH OF CONTRACT



The violation or omission of any of the provisions of this Agreement shall be grounds for the termination of this Agreement, without prejudice to other remedies available to the aggrieved party. No waiver of any breach of any provision of this Agreement shall constitute a waiver of any prior, concurrent, or subsequent breach of any other provision of this Agreement unless expressly stated.

Article X. AMENDMENTS

This Agreement may not be released, discharged, supplemented, interpreted, amended, varied, or modified in any manner except in writing signed by a duly authorized officer or representative of each of the parties hereto.

Article XI. MISCELLANEOUS

1. All Parties shall comply with Republic Act No. 8293, otherwise known as the Intellectual Property Code of the Philippines.
2. All data or information belonging to or provided by DepEd should be protected and shall not be used without the express written consent of DepEd during the term and even after the termination of the Agreement.
3. Both Parties shall ensure strict compliance with the Data Privacy Act of 2012, its Implementing Rules and Regulations, other relevant laws, and other issuances of the National Privacy Commission
4. Nothing in this Agreement shall constitute a partnership among the parties nor constitute one party the agent of the other parties and vice versa. Except as set out in this Agreement, no party shall have express or implied authority to bind or represent any other party for any purpose whatsoever unless expressly agreed in writing by the party concerned.
5. The parties shall not assign their responsibilities to any third party without prior written notice to the other parties.
6. This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement among the parties and supersedes all previous agreements and all previous undertakings, representations, warranties, and conditions made or given by or on behalf of the parties to the others, relating to the subject matter of this Agreement, whether oral or written, express or implied.
