



**REGIONAL TRAINING OF TRAINERS FOR GRADES 3, 4, 7 AND 8 TEACHERS ON ASSESSMENT WITH FOCUS ON HIGHER ORDER THINKING SKILLS (HOTS)**

To: Assistant Regional Director

1. The Regional Office, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD), will conduct a Regional Training of Trainers for teachers handling Grades 3, 4, 7, and 8. The training will focus on integrating 21st-century skills and Higher-Order Thinking Skills (HOTS) into classroom assessments on June 2-4, 2025 at Brentwood Apartelle, Roxas Street, Brentwood Village, Baguio City

2. The objectives of the activity are as follows:
- Constructing assessment questions that develop 21st-century skills and apply the SOLO Taxonomy for HOTS;;
  - Develop classroom assessment skills, knowledge of exam system and critical understanding of assessment using HOT-SOLO align to 21<sup>st</sup> century skills.
  - Align the Table of Specifications (TOS) of SMART assessment tools with the revised K to 10 Curriculum for Grades 3, 4, 7, and 8;
  - Enhance existing SMART assessment tools to ensure quality and alignment with learning standards.

3. Each Schools Division Office (SDO) shall send twelve (12) participants, including assessment coordinators and identified developers/trainers. Participants should preferably be Master Teachers or Teacher III with expertise in assessment design.
