- 4. The Schools Division shall give Special Brigada Awards to the schools that exemplify unique ways of implementing Brigada Eskwela and Brigada Pagbasa. All School categories (small, medium, large, mega) can still vie for the special awards. All schools are encouraged to join the event. See attached criteria, Annexes B and C.
- 5. School entries must submit their documents on or before November 8, 2024, to the Schools Division Office. Division validation commences on November 11 through December 6, 2024. A separate issuance will be posted for the selection and awarding of Best Brigada Implementers. See Annex D.
- 6. Immediate dissemination to all concerned is desired.
