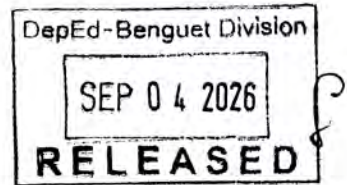

**PROVISION OF ALTERNATIVE LEARNING SYSTEM (ALS) PROGRAM
SUPPORT FUND FOR IMPLEMENTING SCHOOLS/ COMMUNITY
LEARNING CENTERS (CLCs)**

1. Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 028, s. 2022, Republic Act No. 11510, and its Implementing Rules and Regulations, this Office informs concerned schools of the downloading of the Alternative Learning System (ALS) Program Support Fund (PSF) to identified ALS implementing schools/Community Learning Centers (CLCs) to support ALS programs, projects, and activities responsive to learner needs.
2. The Schools Division Office of Benguet, through the Curriculum Implementation Division-Alternative Learning System (CID-ALS), has allocated ₱1,095,500.00 from the ALS Program Support Fund (PSF) for downloading to identified ALS implementing schools/CLCs. The list of recipient schools/CLCs and their corresponding allocations is reflected in the attached enclosure.
3. Recipient schools/CLCs shall be guided by DepEd Order No. 028, s. 2022 and DepEd Order No. 001, s. 2026 in the utilization, monitoring, and reporting of the fund. All expenditures shall be directly related to ALS implementation and subject to existing budgeting, accounting, procurement, and auditing rules.
4. The fund shall support school/CLC-based ALS Programs, Projects, and Activities (PPAs), which may include:
 - a. Learning Enhancement and Functional Literacy Activities – contextualized learning, remediation, enrichment, and development or reproduction of learning resources;

b. Life, Career, and Skills Development Activities – livelihood, entrepreneurship, digital literacy, financial literacy, and other competency-based activities aligned with ALS Learning Strands; and

c. Learner Engagement, Retention, and Community Participation Activities – activities promoting attendance, retention, advocacy, stakeholder engagement, career guidance, life skills, and community support.

5. School Heads, in coordination with ALS teachers and implementers, shall ensure that proposed activities and expenditures are reflected in the school/CLC plans and Work and Financial Plan (WFP) and are responsive to learner needs. Procurement and utilization of supplies, materials, equipment, and other allowable expenses shall comply with existing government rules.

6. Implementing schools/CLCs shall ensure that their PPAs support the Revised ALS Curriculum and the delivery of the Basic Literacy Program, Accreditation and Equivalency Elementary, Accreditation and Equivalency Junior High School, and Senior High School (SHS) programs, as applicable.

7. Recipient schools/CLCs shall maintain complete supporting documents, including approved activity plans, WFPs, procurement and financial documents, attendance sheets, activity documentation, learner outputs, and accomplishment reports, as applicable.

8. School Heads shall ensure the proper, timely, and judicious utilization and liquidation of the downloaded funds. Required utilization and accomplishment reports shall be submitted to the Curriculum Implementation Division through the Division ALS Focal Person for consolidation and monitoring.

9. The Curriculum Implementation Division, through the Division ALS Focal Person, concerned Public Schools District Supervisors (PSDSs)/Public Schools District In-Charge (PSDI), and Education Program Specialists for ALS (EPSAs), shall monitor fund utilization and PPA implementation and provide the necessary technical assistance to recipient schools/CLCs.

10. Immediate dissemination of and strict compliance with this Memorandum is directed.
