DISTRIBUTION OF USB FLASH DRIVES AND SPEAKER RADIOS FOR USE OF

GRADE 1 LEARNERS RELATIVE TO THE VIDEO-BASED AND AUDIO-BASED

LESSONS FOR BEGINNING READING IN MOTHER TONGUE

 As one major intervention in ensuring learning continuity spelled out under the Basic Education-Learning Continuity Operational Plan (BE-LCOP), the Schools Division of Benguet has embarked on the production of video-based and audio-based lessons in the different learning areas including Mother Tongue as complementary learning resources for distance learning.

2. Included in these video and audio-based materials are series of lessons in Beginning Reading in Mother Tongue as guided by the developed Primer in Kankanaey, Ibaloy, Kalanguya, and Karao.

3. To immediately use these materials for the benefit of Grade 1 learners, a total of SDO funded 2, 406 USB flash drives containing the files of locally produced audio-video based lessons in Beginning Reading in Mother Tongue shall be proportionately distributed to the 14 districts. Each district shall also be provided with 4-5 mini-bluetooth speaker radios, which were earlier donated to the division. The distribution is as follows:

- 4. Public Schools District Supervisors/District Heads shall facilitate the subsequent distribution of these USB flash drives to identified priority schools in the district having learners at risk in Grade 1 and provide the necessary technical assistance including proper demonstration of the use of the audio-video materials through speaker radios or available TV or computer desktops.
- 5. The scheduled district gathering of school heads and parents, dubbed as "ASPUAN de Parentes" as per SDO Memorandum 31 s. 2021, shall be maximized as avenue for the advocacy and demonstration of use of these audio-video lesson materials.
- 6. After the "Aspuan de Parentes," each school is expected to fully utilize these audio-video lessons in Beginning Reading for Grade 1 learners.
- 7. Members of the Division Integrated Monitoring Team are also enjoined to continuously monitor the implementation of this undertaking and provide the necessary technical assistance.

8. Immediate dissemination of this memorandum is enjoined.
